

Level 3 Technical Official (Olympic Weightlifting)

Designed to test your knowledge and experience as a Technical Official in Olympic Weightlifting, this course will allow you to progress through the pathway as a higher qualified Technical Official.

What will I learn?

The course covers a mixture of questions designed to test your knowledge and experience as a Technical Official in Olympic Weightlifting to help you progress up the pathway to become a higher qualified Technical Official.

As part of the course you will be asked to submit a signed code of conduct and following this section of the course, you will need to complete two invigilated groups at a competition to complete the course.

What does this course qualify me to do?

Upon successful completion of this award, you will be qualified to officiate at a host of events across the UK.

Holding a Level 3 award you will be able to officiate at Tier 1, 2 and 3 events. Roles include side referee, centre referee, speaker, time keeper, assistant marshall, marshall, technical controller and weigh in duties. All roles will be selected dependant on experience.

Prerequisites

You must hold a level 2 Technical Officials certificate, have completed four tier 3 competitions and two tier 2 competitions and hold a valid BWL Technical Officials licence.
