

Level 4 Technical Official Award (IWF Category 2)

Following the IWF rules, this course is the next stage in the Technical Official pathway for Technical Officials who are qualified to Level 3, have been active at competitions for a minimum of 5 years and who wish to progress to IWF Category 2.

What will I learn?

You will be asked to take the Level 4 exam which has 100 questions. You will then be asked to invigilate at a national championship (Tier 1 & 2) where you are required to adjudicate a minimum of 100 completed lifts.

To become a Level 4 Technical Official (IWF Category 2) you must reach a pass rate of 90% with the combined invigilation and exam questions.

What does this course qualify me to do?

Once you have passed your IWF Exam, you will be qualified as a Technical Official at all BWL tiered events, European Championships, Commonwealth Games and other International events. This excludes the World & University Championships and Olympic Games.

Roles include side referee, centre referee, speaker, time keeper, assistant marshall, marshall, technical controller, weigh in duties and jury at national events.

Prerequisites

You must be a Level 3 Technical Official and have been active at national level competitions (tiers 1 & 2) for 3 years.
